


# Truly Tasty

# Recipes



*Truly Tasty* is a unique cookery book in that all the recipes have been created by Ireland's top chefs for adults living with kidney disease in Ireland. The book is the brainchild of Valerie Twomey, herself a kidney transplant recipient. Over the last year and more, Val has asked Ireland's best chefs to create recipes for the book. The recipes then went through a vigorous process of analysis by the Irish Nutrition & Dietetic Institute who used a coding system based on the Irish diet sheet and the Irish method of educating adults with chronic kidney disease (CKD) and those on dialysis.

The result is a mouth-watering cookbook with stunning food photography by Hugh McElveen and tempting recipes such as Melon and raspberries with cinnamon jelly and basil from Ross Lewis, Chargrilled fillet of beef with ratatouille from Derry Clarke, Tarragon plaice en papillote with julienne vegetables and chive mash from Clodagh McKenna and Pavlova with passion fruit and kiwi from Rachel Allen. The book also includes wonderfully colourful interviews with each chef conducted by journalist Brian Moore.

There are over 100 recipes in the book from 30 chefs that are suitable to enjoy within the renal diet guidelines but the book must only be used carefully as part of an overall diet plan.

As each person is unique, all those on a renal diet must check their dietary allowances to make sure they have enough, for each individual recipe they choose, from *Truly Tasty*. Any specific queries should be directed to the person's dietitian.
